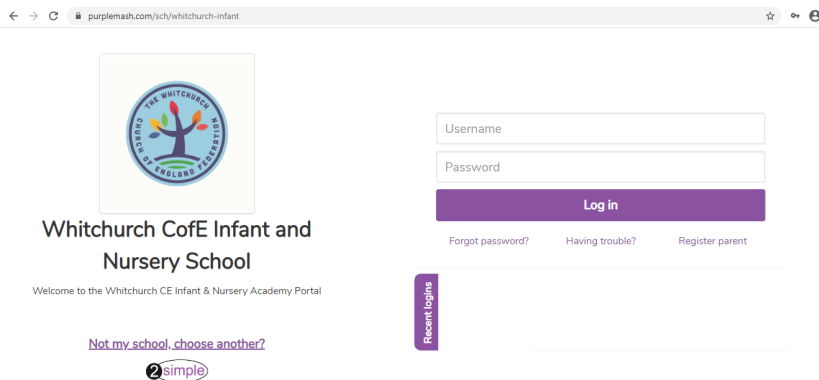


Purple Mash Quick Guide

To support learning at home all children have access to Purple Mash. This is a safe online learning site for children. Your child's log-in card is in their planner. This is a quick introduction to help you and your child access learning. Children in KS1 have been on this site before but Reception may need some support to get started.

It may ask for you to create a parent login, your child can enter the site without it.

You can access the site via a link on the school website home learning page, search for Purple Mash or use this address <https://www.purplemash.com/sch/whitchurch-infant>



This is the login page.

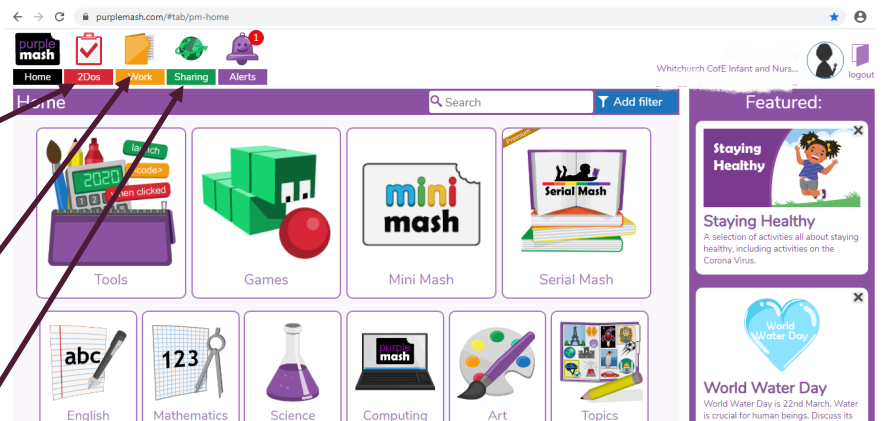
User name and password are on your child's login card. We have set the password to be 2 pictures to make it as simple as possible. Click in the password box and pictures will pop up to choose from.

This is the home page which will take your child to games and activities.

Learning and work to be completed are in the 2Do section.

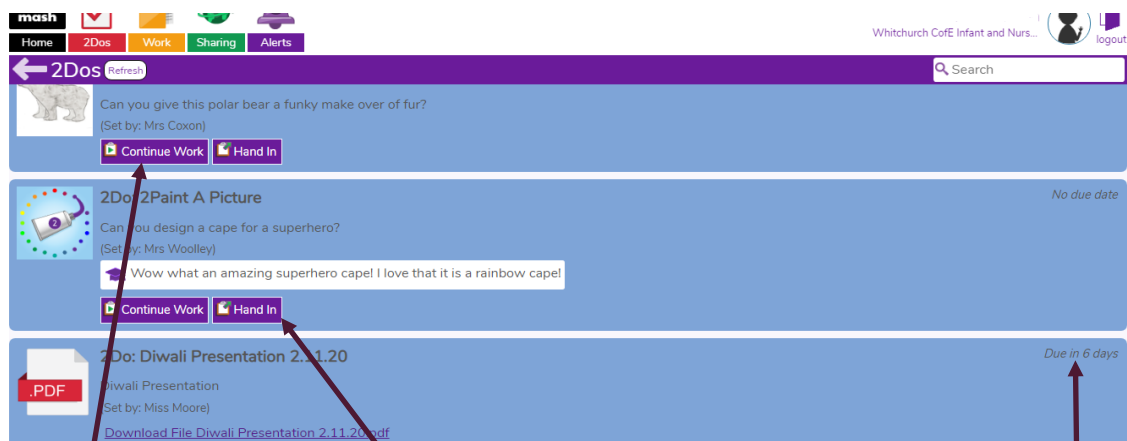
The work folder is where your child's work is stored.

Sharing is where class blogs can be found when they are live.



Home learning can be found in the 2Do section.

Clicking on 2Do opens a page that looks like this. Learning, activities, videos and games are saved here for your child to access view and complete.



This button lets children start/continue work.

This button lets your child "Hand in" finished work.

This shows when work is to be finished by.
